A taste of Brazil

Boca Loca is a Brazilian cachaça – a full-bodied, fragrant spirit. Although officially considered rum, cachaça is distilled through a different process. While rum is made from molasses of sugar cane, cachaça is produced straight from the juice of unrefined sugar cane. Cachaça is the third-most-consumed liquor in the world. The most popular cocktail made with cachaça is the caipirinha, the national drink of Brazil. Boca Loca is available at finer bars, restaurants and liquor stores across the country. The suggested retail for a 750 milliliter bottle is \$20.
